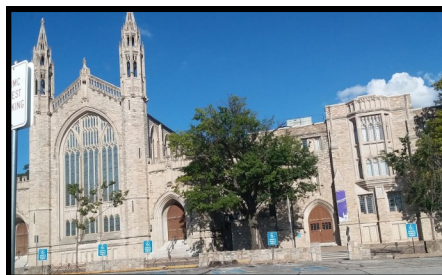

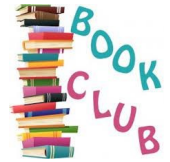

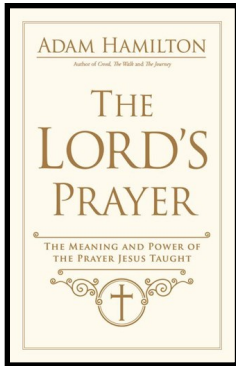

handwarmers

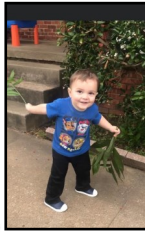
band-aids
