



We've been looking at activities and outreach possibilities for the past six months, and rollout is now in full motion! Thank heavens we have Bobby Oertel leading the parade. Keep tuned to emails and the mid-week newsletter as we move into August. If you have memorabilia for our historical exhibits, we need to know! Photos? Awards? Trophies? All are welcome this month. What a great opportunity it is to be a part of UUMC at 100 years!

The upcoming fall season and new school year kickoff will bring a number of commitments to the front for us. UUMC will provide a cooling and water station for TU's move-in week. We will also have a presence at their Activities Fair, as will Double Flag Coffee. These kickoff events will provide all of us a number of opportunities to be out among "the people" as we demonstrate that we are available, willing and close at hand to all students, both on campus and off. Don't hesitate to sign-up when the opportunity presents itself! "Stand up and BE the church!"

Double Flag Coffee continues to look for a General Manager candidate. There are some possibilities, but still in the early discovery stages. We are very hopeful at this juncture that our event calendar, as well as staffing, will be full come September. DFC participated in Pride as you know, and they will be at the Tulsa Wedding Show the last week of July. I am still hopeful we have people who would like to engage in our LLC and start the learning curve by cleaning the coffee trailer. Let me know. It's not a huge commitment and will be a small team environment. Our name is on that trailer, you know!

I'm thrilled to report that Propel has successfully leased all three of our open spaces formerly occupied by Housing Solutions on the second floor. Dennis Baker, a local candidate for Congressional District 1 has leased one space, a tech company another, and the third vacancy was just filled this week! Tami Losoncy with Propel has done a stellar job of engaging all of us, communicating and advertising the space and its offerings, both through her network and through us as a congregation. That's what it takes in today's business climate .... you tell everybody you know in hopes that one little discussion will "stick". Don't forget to greet anyone you do not know since they could likely be tenants or customers of tenants. Tami is also taking the lead to finish the work formalizing a new (west) parking lot lease agreement with TU. Our Board of Trustees will review and sign once we agree on mutually acceptable terms.




